

Official Minutes 11.5.08

The November monthly meeting was called to order by Vernon Willenbring at 8:30 pm. The flag pledge was said. All members were present. Also present was Ryan Eiden and members of the Farming Community Center Board.

The October minutes were read. Two corrections were made to the October 7 minutes – that the final plat for the Mergen Addition was “approved” and that the meeting on October 24 was the “Stearns County Town Officers Meeting”. Ted Bruemmer made a motion to accept the minutes with the corrections, Fred Holthaus seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Patti Legatt gave a financial report.

RE: Legatt Gravel Mining Operation – Ryan Eiden asked if the Township had reached an agreement with the Legatt Mining Operation. Discussion was held. No agreement had been discussed yet. The supervisors will be checking into this.

RE: Community Center Room Rental – The Community Center Board presented a notice to the Township Board asking for a 10% increase in the annual rent. Discussion was held.

RE: Clear Lake Road – Vernon Willenbring reported that he had found someone to cut the trees along Clear Lake Road for the wood and he had contacted land owners. Discussion was held concerning liability issues, legal responsibility, need for warning signs, etc. It was decided that the Clerk would contact the insurance agency to get some clarification on these issues.

RE: 218th Ave – It was reported that work is in progress along the road. It will be checked into and reported back at the next meeting.

RE: Judy Bruemmer reported that all went well at the General Election. There were 61 new registrations. The ‘Youth Vote’ sponsored by the school district worked well and caused very little interruption.

RE: 317th & Fifth Lake Road – Leon Wieber asked the supervisors to check these roads for issues in the right-of-way.
