Official Minutes 4.6.10

The April monthly meeting was called to order by Fred Holthaus at 8:30 pm. The flag pledge was said. All members were present. Also present were Jay Netter, Tony Legatt, Mike Nelson, Ted Bruemmer, Ron Backes, Dale Lange, Craig Bardson, Brian Brix, and John Kotzer.

The March minutes were read. Two corrections were made: to the 3.8.10 minutes it was noted that residential property values had "decreased" 6 to 7 %, and to the 3.16.10 Reorganization Meeting minutes it was noted that Neil Franz was present but did not participate as his Certificate of Election could not be presented until 3.17.10.

Vernon Willenbring made a motion to accept the 3.8.10 minutes with the correction, Neil Franz seconded. All in favor, motion carried. Neil Franz made a motion to accept the Board of Canvass minutes, Vernon Willenbring seconded. All in favor, motion carried. Vernon Willenbring made a motion to accept the Reorganization Meeting minutes with the correction, Neil Franz seconded. All in favor, motion carried. Neil Franz made a motion to accept the 3.18.10 minutes, Vernon Willenbring seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

A financial report was given by Patti Legatt.

RE: 2011 Levy Proposal – Ron Backes questioned the additional \$5000.00 levy amount for the Farming Baseball Field Project. It was stated that the amount was voted on and approved at the annual meeting, and that those present from the Farming Baseball Team did not make up a majority of the voters.

RE: Fifth Lake Road – Mike Nelson from MN Engineering & Construction Services gave a report on Fifth Lake Road. Dale Lange gave additional input. Discussion was held. Fred Holthaus made a motion to authorize Mike Nelson to go ahead with plans to advertise for blacktopping bids for the road, Vernon Willenbring seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

RE: Crackfilling — One quote was received for crackfilling. Brian Brix stated he would crackfill for \$1.10# - the same amount as last year. Neil Franz made a motion to accept the Brix quote, Vernon Willenbring seconded. All in favor, motion carried. The crackfilling would begin in the near future, weather permitting.

RE: Blading Contract — Discussion was held before the opening of the quotes. It was decided to only accept the quotes "by the mile", not hourly. Two quotes were received. Craig Bardson's quote was \$39.50/mile, Dale Lange's quote was \$34.50/mile. Neil Franz made a motion to accept the quote from Lange Trenching at \$34.50/mile, Vernon Willenbring seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

RE: Dog Complaint – The clerk received a complaint stating that a township resident was bitten by a dog owned by Chris Harrum. The resident did not seek medical treatment or report the incident to the authorities. The dog's owner was made aware of the incident at the time. Fred Holthaus stated that he would speak to Harrum about the incident.

RE: The Spring Newsletter was reviewed and will be sent out within the month.
