Further discussion was held regarding repairs that needed to be done to Fifth Lake Road before tarring. Neil Franz made a motion to have Mike Nelson from MN Engineering and Construction to develop a concise list of specifications for the repair of Fifth Lake Road including, but not limited to, the north 250 feet with 15 inch excavation, possible recycling of useful gravel, fabric installation, tile in east ditch and make them available to contractors so that quotes would be available at an extended meeting on Tuesday, June 8 at 8:00 pm, Vernon Willenbring seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

RE: Mapleview South – Neil Franz reported that approvals to improve the road have been received from county and environmental agencies. He will meet with Mike Nelson to work up a plan and estimate of costs for the road improvement.

RE: CapX 2020 – Mr. Brix asked for an update on the electrical project. The board review information received from CapX 2020. Discussion was held. Mr. Brix also inquired about a field approach permit west of his farmsite, possibly 40 feet in length. Vernon Willenbring made a motion to approve the field approach, Neil Franz seconded. Motion carried. Mr. Brix was told to contact Bill Otto about the permit and to contact Vernon Willenbring about the culvert.

RE: Chain of Lakes Fire and Rescue District – A report was given on the Fire District meetings. It was noted that the Joint Powers Agreement has been signed and that things are moving forward. Discussion was held.

RE: Weed Inspection – The supervisors decided to take 12 sections each and do weed inspection. Residents with noxious weeds will be contacted.
