The June monthly meeting was called to order by Vernon Willenbring at 8:15 pm. All members were present. Also present were Bill Otto, Ron Kalthoff, Donald Linz, Math Schmitz, Brian & Anne Brix, Craig Bardson, Tony Legatt and Adam Orbeck.

The May minutes were read. Neil Franz made a motion to accept the minutes as read, Dan Stommes seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

Patti Legatt gave a financial report.

RE: Zoning – At the public hearing held earlier this evening (7:30 pm to 8:10 pm) the Farming Township Zoning Board approved the Farming Township Land Use and Zoning Ordinance #3. Based on the recommendation of the zoning board to approve the Memorandum of Understanding regarding Land Use Ordinance #3, Neil Franz made a motion to adopt the Farming Township Land Use and Zoning Ordinance #3, Dan Stommes seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

RE: Ditch Cutting – Only one quote was received for ditch cutting. Math Schmitz bid was \$60/hr plus fuel using a 70 hp tractor and 8 ft disc. Neil Franz made a motion to hire Math Schmitz to cut the township road ditches, Dan Stommes seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

RE: Dustcoating – Neil Franz reported that June 16, 2011 was the date set for dustcoating Farming Township roads. Discussion was held and roads to be dustcoated were mapped out.

RE: Noise Complaint – Neil Franz reported he had no more information regarding the Reinke noise complaint but will keep checking on it.

RE: Mapleview Road South – Neil Franz reported that he spoke to Gorecki and suggested \$.25/yd for material to use in the road reconstruction project. He has still not heard back. Discussion was held. It was decided to follow up with Mike Nelson of MN Engineering about the project and work up some specifications to submit to local contractors.

RE: Shouldering Roads – Discussion was held. It was decided that all tarred roads in the township needed shouldering. Dan Stommes made a motion to hire Wm. Scepaniak to shoulder the roads if he honored his earlier quote of \$9.40/yd for shoulder material, Neil Franz seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

RE: Township Website – Discussion was held. Vernon Willenbring made a motion for Neil Franz to go ahead with the website with Karen Boucher, Dan Stommes seconded. All in favor, motion carried.

RE: COL Fire and Rescue District – Vernon Willenbring gave a short report. Things are moving ahead.

RE: Barker (Silvers) Land – The township has been contacted concerning the land north of Leo's Auto Repair. Discussion was held. Neil Franz will contact them and tell them we have a limit of \$500 and if the cost is more than that we need to have a meeting with the township residents.

RE: Noxious Weeds – Discussion was held. The supervisors each agreed to take 1/3 of the township to check for noxious weeds.
