

FARMING TOWNSHIP
LAND USE AND ZONING ORDINANCE
NUMBER 3

(SUMMARY OF ORDINANCE NUMBER 3)

Farming Township Land Use and Zoning Ordinance Number 2 is adopted pursuant to the authorization and policies contained in Minnesota Statutes, Chapter 365, Minnesota Statutes Chapter 366 and Minnesota Statutes Chapter 462.

Farming Township Land Use and Zoning Ordinance Number 3 shall apply to all areas in Farming Township.

The Scope of Farming Township Ordinance Number 3 is as follows:

Farming Township Ordinance Number 3 sets forth a Statement of Purpose which states specific reasons for which Ordinance Number 3 is enacted; sets forth provision for the administration of Ordinance Number 3; sets forth penalties for violations of the Ordinance; establishes fees to defray administrative costs of processing requests; repeals the existing Farming Township Zoning Ordinance; and adopts certain sections of Stearns County Ordinance Number 439 by reference in which Ordinance Number 439 sets forth performance standards for specific uses that are allowed as permitted, accessory, conditional, interim, or provisional; establishes primary zoning districts and general development standards.
